


## Meet a Dedicated & Zealous Worker





### About Us

Anchor Evangelical Press is a not for profit mission organization that was incorporated under the laws of New York state in 1976 and was granted 501 (c)(3) tax-exempt status by the Internal Revenue Service in October of 1977.

“We have this hope as an anchor for our hearts.” (Hebrews 6:19) The desire of Anchor Evangelical Press is to bring hope to many who sit in darkness. The word Evangelical in our name indicates that we exalt the Lord Jesus Christ in all our publications. We want to proclaim to all men that God lives, that man is lost in sin, that Jesus is the only Savior, Who was born of a virgin, died for our sins on the cross, rose victoriously from the grave and is coming again! The word Press indicates that we have printing presses that are producing booklets and tracts, sending them free of charge to all who make a request.

### Mission Statement

To help fulfill the “Great Commission” of Christ as stated in Matthew 28:19–20 –

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,...teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you...”

We do this through publishing, printing and distributing Christ-centered literature. Our purpose is to provide Christian literature to reach the lost for Christ, to encourage and edify believers and to equip others to fulfill this “Great Commission.



### Our History

Even though our ministry was incorporated in 1976, we actually had our beginnings back in 1953 in Greenwich, Connecticut under the leadership of former missionaries to Africa, Charles and Helen Fricke.

In 1974, the Fricke's retired and moved to S. Carolina. At that time, Charlie and Liz Travis decided to become more actively involved in this unique ministry. This was the beginning of Anchor Evangelical Press' work in Hyde Park, NY.

Since 1974, millions of tracts have been sent from Hyde Park to Africa. Thousands upon thousands of people have come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ as a direct result of this ministry.

As a ministry, we are trusting God to continue to lead and guide us as we endeavor to continue to reach lost souls for Him.
