## FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Because Bibles, Bible Commentaries, study materials and tracts are so prevalent in this country, it is hard to believe that this is not the case in poverty stricken nations. One report I read recently said that "over 100 million church-goers in Africa still do not have their own copy of the Bible. Church growth in Africa has been so fast it has been almost impossible to keep up with supplying Bibles to new converts." Another report that I read said, "The African church is booming but they are **Bible poor**. Over the past several years, churches in sub-Saharan Africa have baptized more than 14.5 million converts per year. Yet, only about one in four of those new Christians has a Bible of their own!"

My experience in Africa would lead me to believe that most Christians don't own their own Bible. While this news is not great, it does encourage this ministry to know that there continues to be a great need in Africa for Bibles and Bible tracts. Recently, we received an e-mail from a Bible School in The Democratic Republic of Congo asking for Bibles for their students. Imagine attending Bible School and not owning a Bible! ## FROM OUR MAILBOX

A pastor from Zambia wrote about an outreach that they did in the town of Mansa, the capital of the Luapula Province. From September 14-22, 2014, a team of 6 pastors were in Mansa to do evangelism. They accomplished this through: door to door evangelism, the Jesus film, open air preaching, tract distribution, and prayer. He reported that 1800 people were reached with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Of these, they recorded 150 professions of faith. I contacted this pastor to see if the tracts he used were the ones we sent him; he responded that they were. Praise God!

## ANOTHER LETTER FROM ZAMBIA

We have continually sent tracts to Christian Tract Distributors for over 40 years. Recently, the pastor that oversees this ministry wrote to tell us that he is using our tracts in prison ministry and open air evangelistic crusades. He shared that many have made a profession of faith in Christ as a result of our tract ministry. At his request, we printed 2500 copies of one of our tracts and put his ministry's name and contact information on the back page. Should anyone in Zambia have a question, they would be able to have a local ministry to contact. We are excited to partner with this African ministry that has "feet on the ground" in Zambia!

## Areas of Need:

- 1) We need "prayer warriors."
- 2) We need volunteers to help us prepare and package our booklet missionaries.
- 3) We need financial partners:
  - ◆ A \$10 donation buys a Bible for a native pastor.
  - ◆ A \$15 donation pays to mail a Bible to a native pastor.
  - ◆ A \$25 donation pays for both the Bible and the cost of mailing.
  - ◆ A \$75 donation pays for the postage to send 500 tracts to Africa.
  - ◆ A \$100 donation pays for the paper and ink to print 500 tracts as well as the cost of mailing.
